**HOST FAMILIES NEEDED.....**Holyoke Catholic High School is looking for families who would be willing to host an international student for the upcoming 2009-2010 school year. At present, they have received applications from two young ladies from Beijing, China.

Prospective host families are subject to a CORI check and will be interviewed by the school and the agency prior to being approved. You receive a monthly stipend for each student you host. Currently, host families are receiving between \$400—\$800 per month depending on the agency sending the student.
